Review of history of cancer

Most of this information is obtained prior to your consultation through notes from your other physicians, and from checklists which you take home and complete at your convenience. Your Medicor physician will then review this information with you at the consultation.

Review of medications

This involves a discussion with your Medicor physician about the risks, benefits, potential interactions, potential complications, costs and compliance of your allopathic (conventional) medications. Adjustments can then be made to improve your medication therapy.

Review of drug and non-drug adverse events and allergies

Often when a patient has a reaction to a drug, it is recorded as an “allergy”. At Medicor, we take extra time to distinguish between true allergies and adverse reactions. This prevents the patient from being denied good medications because of mislabeling of bad reactions as allergies.

Directed physical examination

Your Medicor physician will check various body systems depending on your type of cancer, and current problems.

Blood test, imaging and other specialized tests*

We offer certain specialized tests at our office to allow the most rapid and convenient assessment of our patients. Other tests can be arranged at a nearby lab or imaging centre.
